REPORT ON THE HISTORICAL SAFEX PRICE AS WELL AS THE FUTURE SAFEX PRICE WITH RESPECT TO YELLOW MAIZE AND SOYBEAN

(As on 17 January 2022)

Background

1. The Advisory Committee: Economics and Markets has decided on 12 October 2021 that a "Report on the Historical Safex price as well as the Future Safex Price with respect to Yellow Maize and Soybean" be submitted. (Please refer to the minutes of 12 October 2021, resolution 13.1.1)

"Mr Kraamwinkel said that in terms of the future, it might be worthwhile to bring out a monthly or two monthly report which indicated historical prices and future prices in South Africa, without trying to analyze all the underlying factors. His view was that the collective need was for everyone to understand the historical course of prices and what the future prices would be. He said that if this were to be a monthly Milk SA report, SAMPRO would be able to handle it with reasonable ease; and that it would consist of four graphs. He said that as market signals changed frequently, he would be inclined to say that the four graphs should be provided monthly to reflect the situation."

"Mr Kraamwinkel proposed that the report be sent to the Advisory Committee as a detailed report, with the Work Group's suggestion that a document be produced monthly which contained the four graphs - the reason being that to bring out such a detailed report every month was too time-consuming and would not give greater certainty on future prices than could be deduced from the graphs."

<u>Graph 1: Historical Safex Price – Yellow Maize (January 2016 – December 2021)</u>





Graph 2: Future Safex Price - Yellow Maize (February 2022 - July 2022)




