


REPORT ON THE HISTORICAL SAFEX PRICES AS WELL AS THE FUTURE SAFEX PRICES OF YELLOW MAIZE AND SOYBEANS AS ON 14 NOVEMBER 2022

Background


- 1. During the Industrial Information Work Group meeting of Milk SA, dated 25 January 2022, it was decided that the Office of SAMPRO should submit a monthly report on the historical as well as future Safex price of maize and soybeans.
- 2. The historical and future price movements of maize and soybeans are portrayed within the following four graphs:
 - <u>Historical Safex</u> price information with respect to Yellow Maize for the period January 2017 to October 2022 (see Graph 1);
 - <u>Future Safex</u> price information with respect to Yellow Maize for the period November 2022 to December 2023 as recorded on 14 November 2022 (see Graph 2);
 - <u>Historical Safex</u> price information with respect to Soybeans for the period January 2017 to October 2022 (see Graph 3); and
 - <u>Future Safex</u> price information with respect to Soybeans for the period November 2022 to December 2023 as recorded on 14 November 2022 (see Graph4).



Graph 1: Historical Safex Price - Yellow Maize (January 2017 to October 2022)¹⁾


